Dr Scott McDonald (MA BM BCH MRCSEd FRCR) is a Consultant Musculoskeletal Radiologist, based at Cambridge University Hospitals. He has a broad and busy clinical practice within diagnostic and interventional musculoskeletal radiology.

Following medical training at Oxford and basic surgical training predominantly within the southeast, Scott underwent specialist training in radiology at Cambridge, before selection for prestigious fellowships in musculoskeletal imaging at both the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre, Oxford, and the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital. During his radiological training, Scott studied law at De Montford University, Leicester, leading to the award of a Graduate Diploma in Law in 2007.

Scott is a Fellow of the Royal College of Radiologists, and a member of the British Society of Skeletal Radiologists and the European Society of Radiologists. Scott presents nationally on musculoskeletal imaging themes, contributes to the published literature on MSK topics and acts as a reviewer for Radiology, Orthopaedic and Rheumatology journals.

A consultant since 2011, Dr McDonald has been clinical lead for musculoskeletal imaging at Cambridge University Hospitals, served on the educational board of the highly regarded Cambridge training scheme for radiology and supported anatomy teaching for medical students at Christ's College, Cambridge.
